***** QUALIFICATIONS *****

I. EPDs

- A. Each bull must have individual EPDs (or parents with interim EPDs so that estimated individual EPDs can be calculated) for Birth Weight, Weaning Weight, Milk, and Yearling Weight.
- B. Each bull must have at least ONE EPD that ranks in the top 35% of the breed. The numerical requirement for the top 35% of each of the EPDs is listed with the respective EPD (figures from Spring 2012 report, Non-parent Bulls). To qualify, a bull's EPD must be equal to or greater than the listed EPD except for birth weight and carcass fat, which must be equal to or less than the listed EPD.

- II. FERTILITY:** Each bull must pass a breeding soundness examination administered by a qualified technician within 45 days of the sale. Results of the exam must be recorded on a form provided by and signed by the issuing technician. Forms will be presented to the sale manager along with the customary health paper upon delivery of the bull to the sale facilities.

III. PERFORMANCE DATA

- A. Actual in herd weights will not be required this year, however, CKA strongly recommends that you record birth, weaning, and yearling weights and process these weights through the AHIR program of the American Angus Association.
- B. Sale Weights: All bulls will be weighed upon delivery to the sale facilities and must meet or exceed the following minimums for weight per day of age.

No additional weight requirements over 30 months.

- IV. ULTRASOUND:** No ultrasound requirements will apply for the 2012 sale.

- V. AGE:** Bulls born from 1-1-2009 to 4-30-2011.

VI. FEES

- A. Entry Fees: Premier Bulls must pay an additional fee of \$25.00 each over and above the regular sale entry fees.
- B. Premiums: All additional entry fees collected will be paid as premiums to the top selling bulls. Distribution of premiums will be determined by the sale committee prior to the sale. To qualify for premiums, bulls must be fully paid for and papers must be transferred to the new owner.
- C. Sale Expenses will be calculated the same as the balance of the sale cattle.

VII. MISCELLANEOUS

- A. All bulls must meet the Premier qualifications to be accepted for the sale.
- B. Sale order will be determined by the sale manager in consultation with the Sale Committee.
