The Great Meadows 30<sup>th</sup> Annual Spring Sale will be held on April 28, 2012 at Tom McGinnis' Heritage Farm near Shelbyville, Kentucky. Many thanks to Tom for hosting the Spring Sale, and we look forward to sale day at an excellent location. The Trade Show will once again be a part of the sale activities. The Trade Show helps defray some of the sale expenses and also helps with the crowd. There is still time to enlist more exhibitors, so if you know of any individuals or businesses that might be interested, give Kevin Perkins a call at 502/269-7189.

Bulls, open heifers, bred heifers, cows, and cow/calf pairs are eligible for the sale. Pedigrees and EPDs are more important than ever before, and you really need to watch the age on the cows. Any cows over the 5 to 6 years of age range are heavily discounted by most potential buyers. The bull market for this spring looks very promising, so please consider consigning to this division. Bulls will need a current BSE to sell, and fall yearlings and coming 2 year olds are the preferred age group. Please keep these factors in mind when selecting your consignments.

At a recent meeting of the Great Meadows Angus Association, an Incentive Plan was approved for Juniors who purchase heifers in a GMAA sponsored sale. Under the plan, Juniors who purchase a female from a GMAA sale and then show that female would receive a premium for specified winnings at various levels of competition. Consignors, you may want to pay special attention to consignments that would be eligible for the Juniors to show.
